**Deadline Approaching for Spring Semester  
Single Parent Scholarship Fund of Northwest Arkansas**

**FAYETTEVILLE, Ark.** (Sept. 23, 2020) — The deadline to apply for a traditional scholarship for the Spring 2021 semester from the Single Parent Scholarship Fund of Northwest Arkansas is Oct. 15.

This scholarship is awarded to students seeking an associate degree, bachelor's degree, Master of Arts in Teaching or a licensure in cosmetology or massage therapy. Eligible full-time students can receive up to \$2,000 per semester from the scholarship. Part-time students can receive up to \$1,000 per semester.

To qualify, applicants must be a single parent, and a legal resident of the United States or a resident with Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals (DACA) status. Applicants must also be residents of Carroll, Madison or Washington counties and pursuing a career-oriented course of study at an approved institution.
